Energy and GHG Policy

Purpose

Aratubo has set out an Energy Policy associated with its environmental commitments and strategy as well as Aratubo's management policies, in order to contribute to more efficient use of the energy sources available and the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions.

Scope

The commitment to responsible energy management applies to all Aratubo operations.

Basic Action Principles

As part of its commitment to sustainable development, Aratubo has established the framework to set objectives and actions for efficient energy consumption and reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by defining these basic action principles:

- > Integrate energy management into Aratubo's environmental management pursuant to the legal and regulatory requirements as well as the specifications of international standard ISO 50001.
- > Manage **energy challenges** impacting Aratubo and society in general.
- > Establish Aratubo processes to **control consumption, savings and energy efficiency**.
- > **Improve energy performance**, reducing emissions in equipment and facilities, considering opportunities for improvement in the design and application of new technologies.
- > **Promote the acquisition of energy efficient products and services** and extend these action principles to our value chain.
- > Make progress in the use of energy from renewable sources.
- > Encourage energy efficiency by **training, providing information and raising awareness internally** about energy use and performance.
- > **Provide internal and external communications** on our energy commitments and performance, verifying the latter with an accredited external institution.
- > **Continuously improve** the effectiveness of the Management System by applying the actions arising from audits, monitoring activity and analysis of energy performance results.
- > **Collaborate** with other companies and institutions in favour of a low carbon economy.

Monitoring and Oversight Systems

The **Sustainability Committee** periodically monitors indicators, achievement of the objectives and actions carried out.
